Parker Towing Company's Fleet Has an Addition



M/V Alison Haun brings the M/V Miss Kim to Northport

The M/V Miss Kim was purchased by Parker Towing Company on October 15, 2004. The motor vessel was built in 1974 and is 55 feet long by 22 feet wide. The M/V Miss Kim is powered by two Detroit 12V71 engines which account for the boat's 800 hp. The gross registered tonnage for the vessel is

78 tons.

The motor vessel ended its 6 day trek to Northport on October 29, 2004. Initially the boat was in the care of Captain Bill Archie and Relief Captain Glen Freeman of the M/V Heloise. After reaching Demopolis, care was transferred to Captain Curtis Taylor and Pilot Kenneth Jones



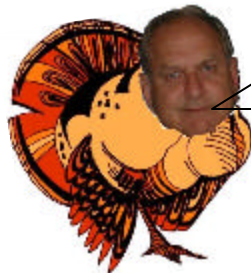

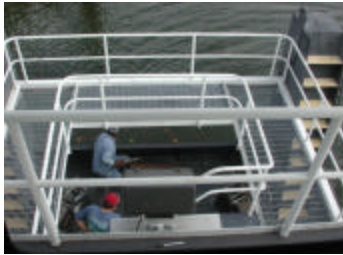
